About our new apprenticeship

The Specialist Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship Level 5 is a 24-month apprenticeship that prepares individuals to support learners across various educational settings, including primary, secondary, special schools, and further education institutions.

Specialist teaching assistants work with students of all ages, focusing on either Special Educational Needs (SEND), Social and Emotional Well-being, or Physical Education (PE). The role involves planning, implementing, and adapting learning activities while drawing on research and reflective practice.

Specialist teaching assistants build relationships with learners, families, and professionals, contributing to the development of inclusive, supportive learning environments. They are responsible for supporting both individual and group learning, ensuring student safety, and assisting with assessment and evaluation processes. Additionally, they may train and support colleagues in their specialist area.

Specialist Options

Social and Emotional Well-being

This option empowers apprentices to enhance learners' self-awareness, emotional understanding, and empathy, improving behaviour and attendance, distinct from the SEND option focused on Social, Emotional, and Mental Health (SEMH) needs.

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

This option equipping colleagues with specialist expertise to support children and young people with SEND, it enables them to thrive and highlights the critical role of support staff in assisting vulnerable learners.


Curriculum Provision Specialist - PE

This specialist option develops apprentices' expertise in delivering engaging, inclusive physical education, promoting children's health, well-being, and a lifelong love of movement and sport.



Entry requirements

- Minimum Grade 4 (C) or above at GCSE in English and Maths or equivalent.
- 12 months' experience working in a school environment.


